Job Description

A team member for the Order of Lumen Gentium is a young adult Catholic, with a deep love of Christ and an embrace of the Church, who desires to share that love with others.

He or she is passionate about the Catholic faith, demonstrates strong morals, and lives in harmony with Church teaching. He or she has a personal relationship with Christ and communicates the joy of fostering that relationship. This relationship is expressed in a variety of ways but above all in the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation.

For those wishing to apply for membership:

- Ministerial background or experience is preferred, such as involvement in parish youth ministry, parish religious education, Catholic high school, college campus ministry, FOCUS Bible studies, young adult ministry, discernment groups, etc.
- Willingness to grow in knowledge and experience of the Church's teaching on human dignity and Theology of the Body
- Willingness to share their love of Christ and the Church to various audiences in the Archdiocese of Mobile of varying age groups. He or she is comfortable with public speaking in a timely and engaging manner.
- Openness to growth in their relationship with Christ and the ministry in which He calls them.
- Ability to relate and connect with young people in a way that demonstrates an understanding of the challenges faced by young people today
- Willingness to travel to parishes and schools for ministerial opportunities. Nights and weekend events are common. After the training is completed, no event is mandatory, however members will reply as to their availability to the event.

This group of young adults who either live or attend school in the Archdiocese are formed, trained, and mentored by the Offices of Religious Education and Youth Ministry.
